PARENTS - DROP-OFF/PICK-UP LOCATIONS

- ☐ It is recommended that students use public transport or parents drop students away from the school to avoid the traffic congestion that is likely to occur.
- ☐ Subiaco Road and/or Hamilton Street and /or Roberts Road.
- ☐ Parking/vehicular entry to school grounds is by permit only
- ☐ Parent vehicles are not permitted in permit parking areas

WHERE TO MEET

- ☐ Year 7 students meet at the Stokes building at 8.25am
- ☐ New Year 8, 9, 10 and 11 students are required to meet at Student Services at 8.25am. They will be greeted by their Head of Year and student buddies.
