Track & Field Events Coaching Workshop 2025

Workshop (Practical) Includes:

- Basic technical model of all athletic events (except for steeplechase, hammer throw and pole vault, which are covered at the Event Group Specialist Coach Courses)
- Practical drills to assist in the conditioning process
- Warm up and flexibility

There are no pre-requisites for this course, but some familiarity with the sport will be assumed.

Please note: This workshop is practical in content. Participation is optional but recommended.

There is also an **online Foundation Course run by ATFCA national office** (please see website http://atfca.com.au). The online Foundation Coaching course covers the processes of coaching, with particular emphasis on young novice athletes. Fee is separate from that of the workshop and includes track and field events, role of the coach, safety & the law, conditioning, the instructional process, basic biomechanics, anatomy & physiology, program planning, coaching manual & discounted ATFCA membership fee to the end of 2025.

This relatively new course includes all the elements of the previous ATFCA Level 1 course and some components of the previous Level 2. It is somewhat equivalent to AA's Level 2 course. After the completion of the online Foundation course, participants may pursue the next course: Event Group Specialist in sprints & hurdles or middle & long distance or throws or jumps.

The workshops described above supplement/support the online Foundation coaches' course.
